



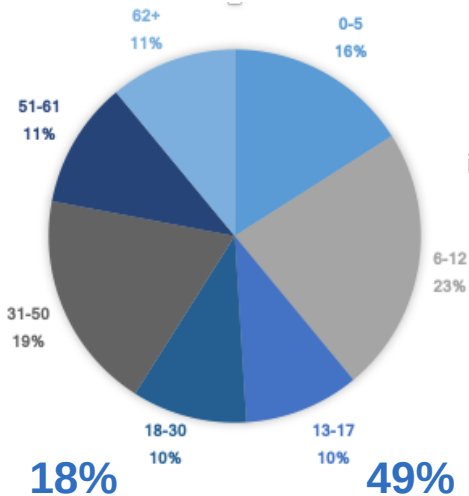

## STORY OF HOPE:

Despite preparing for the future, extended unemployment took a toll on the Jones family. Out of a job for some time, David and his wife Angela weren't sure where to turn. Before long, they received what they called a "real blessing"—a referral to the CCC from the AL Hotline. Teetering on the edge, the family used the CCC's services as they needed, and participated in seasonal programs, received help with clothing, and visited the Food Pantry to make it through a particularly hard time. The family's strong faith, combined with the CCC's assistance and the goodwill of neighbors got them through a very difficult period. Today, David has returned to work, and the family is solidly on its feet. They describe their time with the CCC as "one blessing after another."

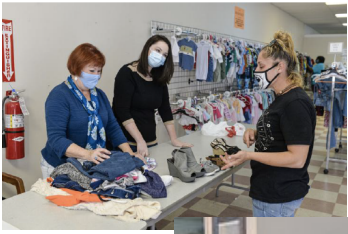

## 48 Years of Serving Morgan County

For 48 years, the CCC has led a community-wide effort to end hunger and alleviate the struggles of poverty in Morgan County. With the help of business partners, area schools, affiliated churches, service clubs and hundreds of volunteers, the CCC helps those who need us most by providing basic needs:

- 1 Food: We are serious about ending hunger in our service area through our Food Pantry and food programs which provides over \$500,000 worth in free groceries every year. Our programs include a food pantry, holiday assistance, and homeless "travel bags,"
- 2 Clothing: Over 400 households receive gently used clothing and linens free of charge through the Clothing Closets. The program saved clients nearly \$300,000, calculated at thrift store prices
- 3 Household Assistance and Emergency Funds: Case management by the CCC's client services team results in aid for medical supplies, medication, transportation, and other critical needs. We even help out with household items for people who are experiencing crisis or having to start over. Over 1,000 individuals received support in 2021
- 4 Help for Children: No child has to go without thanks to assistance with formula, diapers, wipes, and other needed items. We diapered 125 babies this year alone.
- 5 Seasonal Programs: The CCC provides seasonal and holiday assistance to relieve stress and allow families to use their limited resources for basic needs, such as rent and utilities. Over 2,443 boxes of school supplies were supplied to Decatur Schools, 150 families and individuals received Thanksgiving baskets, and hundreds of children will be served by our Christmas Toy Room in 2021
